Labelling of entries

Please ensure that all lots are clearly labelled with your client number and that this form is completed. The porter has absolute discretion to refuse items considered unsuitable for the sale. Any lots which fail to attract a bid will be disposed of the following week unless collected immediately after the sale.

Right of Title

The Seller warrants to Locke & England and to the Buyer that he has and will be able to transfer, good and marketable title to lots entered free from all third party rights or claims on the fall of the hammer.

Electrical Testing

All portable single purchase electrical appliances are tested for safety and a £3 charge is made per test (pass or fail). All items must have an approved plug fitted. Items which fail will be sold in the trade only auction.

Payment

Vendor settlement of the net proceeds of sale after deduction of charges is made by cheque or by Bank Transfer approximately 21 days after the sale.

The Auctioneers will withhold payment on any lot until the purchaser of that lot has settled their account. Vendors collecting proceeds will be asked to prove their identity. It is agreed that the Auctioneers take their charges on completion of the sale and may earn interest on credit balances.

Lots withdrawn prior to the sale will be charged at 15% of the reserve or Auctioneers estimate plus VAT.
